Wrap up meeting at Patterson on Monday at 12:00 noon.

Location: Parklands

Water bodies: Patterson Lake, Tokaruk Lake, Spear Lake, E & W Goose, Twin

How to get there from Winnipeg: Take the Trans Canada west and then, after Portage, take the Yellowhead Highway as far as Shoal Lake. Turn north on #21 to Oakburn. Continue due North across #45 and 9 km on to #577. Patterson lake is the first lake on the left after the road turns to gravel. Tokaruk is on the east, 1 mile down the road opposite the mass grave sign. (about 275Km from Winnipeg). Spear Lake is north of Russell. Goose lakes are in the town of Roblin, Twin Lakes are north of Roblin.

Species: Rainbow and Brown Trout up to 25 in. Tigers at Twin.

Rod suggestion: 5 to 8 weight

Line suggestion: Sinking tip or full sinking, 1X to 2X tippet.

Fly suggestion: Streamers of all types, nymphs.
