Position Summary

Under the direction of the Park Works Supervisor or designate the incumbent performs labourer services on the South Whiteshell Trail System in the South Whiteshell District in the Provincial Park. The duration of the volunteer position is from _____ to _____, 2017.

Duties and Responsibilities

20% Clean-up and removal of refuse and debris from campsites, trails, waterways and other areas including remote locations.

20% Use hand tools; shovels, picks, axe, sledge hammer, rakes etc.

20% Perform hand excavation / backfill required for construction and landscaping

10% Perform a variety of heavy lifting and manual duties associated with trail and campsite maintenance.

10% Collection of garbage and recyclables.

10% Load and unload materials.

10% Perform other similar duties as assigned.

- The volunteer must report to the site supervisor any damage to equipment, any injuries, all issues pertaining to the safety of public, volunteers or employees, and any issues that may adversely affect the experience of our park visitors.
- Volunteers must be physically capable of performing the above duties in all weather conditions.
- Volunteers must wear safety equipment as instructed by their supervisor, volunteers may be required to provide their own safety equipment depending on duties including safety boats and lifejackets.
- Public complaints and comments should be re-directed to the supervisor.
